Boulder City Police Respond To Report of Explosive Device

On October 17, 2009, at approximately 1:26 p.m., a Boulder City resident, living in the 1500 block of Becky Lane, reported finding an explosive device in their driveway. Boulder City Police Officers responded and located what they believed to be a small homemade explosive device in the front yard of the reporting party's residence.

Officers contacted the Las Vegas Fire Bomb Squad, set up a perimeter and evacuated several houses in the immediate vicinity. The LV Fire / Rescue Bomb Squad and LVMPD Armor Unit responded and rendered the device safe. All displaced residents were able to return to their homes within two hours.

Based upon their investigation, Boulder City Police Officers arrested a local juvenile for manufacturing an explosive device and subsequently transported him to Clark County Juvenile Hall.

Consolidated Tax for Boulder City

For the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2009-2010, July, August and September, 2009, consolidated tax to Boulder City has declined when compared to the same quarter in 2008. At the end of the quarter, consolidated tax totaled \$1,908,250. This is approximately 23% of the \$8.2 million budgeted by the Finance Department for this fiscal year.

In order to add some perspective to this decline, it should be noted that consolidated tax has been declining for the past several years. In Fiscal Year 2007, the actual tax received was \$8,819,003; and the City budgeted \$9,081,821. In Fiscal Year 2008, actual tax received was \$8,498,661; and the City budgeted \$8,810,000. In Fiscal Year 2009, actual tax received was \$8,048,686; and the City budgeted \$8,725,000.

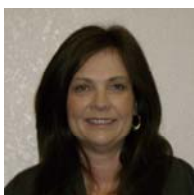
