Permits for Manufactured Housir

You may be wondering what improvements to your manufactured home require a building permit through the City, so we have created a short list to provide you with that information. The following types of work associated with manufactured housing require a building permit:



- The construction, alteration, or modification of detached structures accessory to manufactured homes, on the same lot, in excess of 120 square feet.
- Continuous footings for the support of manufactured housing. This condition is applicable for conversions to real property and standard setup for skirting, foundation support and enclosure.
- The construction and attachment of awnings and carports whose live load is more than 20 pounds per square foot. Such structures shall not be attached to a manufactured home or mobile home, except for flashing for waterproofing.
- For new single family homes on residential lots, connection to all public utilities will be permitted and inspected by Building and Safety Division staff.

Other types of work for your manufactured home require permits which are issued by the State of Nevada Manufactured Housing Division. Those types of work include:

- The replacement of water heaters and air conditioning equipment
- Utility hookups (sewer, gas and electric to existing pedestals) of moved structures to existing spaces in mobile home parks
- Attachments of light weight metallic structures (awnings, carports, steps and porches)


