

BOULDER CITY PARKS AND RECREATION YOUTH CENTER POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

All participants must abide by the sign-in requirements of the Boulder City Youth Center.
Participants must follow all posted rules.

Misconduct Policy:

Inappropriate Behavior:

- Step 1. Communicate verbally appropriate behavior
- Step 2. Behavior monitored -- observation log
- Step 3. Suspension (short term -- up to one month)
- Step 4. Suspension (long term -- one month plus)

Behavior Not Tolerated:

1. UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT: Short term suspension (time varies on severity of infraction)
 - A. Disrespectful behavior
 - B. Unnecessary rough tactics against another participant. (i.e., shoving, hitting, etc.)
 - C. Abusive language, foul language or gestures
 - D. Minor damage to the facility or equipment. (must pay to replace or repair)
 - E. Smoking or chewing tobaccoREPEATED BEHAVIOR: One week suspension and required parent conference.
CONTINUED BEHAVIOR: Extended suspension and parent conference.

2. AUTOMATIC SUSPENSION FOR: Long term suspension (varies on severity of infraction) Police will be called for any of the following infractions or suspect of:
 - A. ACTS OF VIOLENCE ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE
(This includes the surrounding area of the Youth Center.)
 - (1). Fighting or physical violence against another person.
 - (2). Major damage to the facility or equipment. (Must pay to replace or repair)
 - (3). Weapons
 - (4). Drugs and drug paraphernalia
 - (5)

This information has been provided for you and your child to ensure consistency in the operational procedures of the Youth Center at 801 Adams Boulevard.
