CSN Concert Band Kicks Off Concert Series in Boulder City

On Saturday, April 18 at 7 p.m., the CSN Concert Band will kick off the annual free concert series at Boulder City Library's outdoor amphitheatre. The concert, titled "Music Around the World" will feature music from America, England, Germany and more.

Dr. Richard McGee founded the CSN Concert Band in 1990 to fill a dual need: to allow serious CSN music students the opportunity to perform quality literature for the symphonic band medium, and to provide a musical outlet for musicians in the community.

Since its founding, the CSN Concert Band has performed over 90 concerts, both at CSN and other venues around the Las Vegas area. The CSN Concert Band is known in the CSN catalog as MUSE 111, a fully accredited course, transferable to other colleges and universities.
