Chief Constable for Boulder Township Arrested

Larry Markotay, the Chief Constable for the Township of Boulder City, was arrested late Monday, February 22, for several traffic-related charges including fleeing the scene of an accident and driving under the influence of alcohol.

At approximately 10:54 p.m., a citizen called 911 and reported that a car had struck a light pole on Utah Street near Seventh Street and the occupants exited the car and left the area on foot.

When Boulder City police arrived at the scene at 10:56 p.m., they immediately recognized the car, a 2003 Ford Crown Victoria, as the duty-vehicle belonging to Chief Constable Larry Markotay.

Officers subsequently located Markotay, 42, at a nearby residence. He was arrested at 11:47 p.m. after failing field sobriety tests. He was booked at the Boulder City police station and subsequently taken to the Henderson County Jail pending appearance before a magistrate with a bail of \$5583.00.

Investigation continues by the Boulder City Police Department.
