Rollover Crash at Nelson Road

On June 6, 2010, at approximately 6:55 p.m., the Boulder City Police and Fire Departments were dispatched to a one-vehicle rollover at milepost three on State Road (SR)165, Nelson Road.

When the first officer arrived at the scene, he found a silver 2004 Volkswagen Passat off the roadway resting on its roof. Inside the vehicle was the driver, Michael Schultz, a 20-year-old male from Henderson and a passenger, Cory Bradbury, a 22-year-old visiting from out of state.

Both occupants were unconscious but breathing. Schultz had injuries to his head and arm, and Bradbury had injuries to his head. Boulder City Fire personnel had to extricate both occupants from the vehicle. Schultz was transported by ambulance to UMC, and Bradbury was airlifted to UMC. Both are listed in critical condition.

SR 165 eastbound traffic was shut down for four hours so officers could investigate the accident. Westbound traffic was routed around the accident.

The accident is still under investigation by the Boulder City Police Department Traffic Safety Bureau. Excessive speed appears to be a major contributing factor.
