Primary Election Results

During the April 7, 2009 Primary Election, a candidate, in order to win a seat on the Council and not have to advance to the General Election, was required to receive votes equal to the majority of voters casting ballots in that election.

The total number of votes cast during early voting, mail in ballots and on April 7 were 3,983. In order for any candidate to be elected to a council position during the Primary Election, a majority of 1,993 votes would have been needed.

Duncan McCoy received 2,000 votes, and was, therefore, elected to the position of Council member in the Primary Election.

Cam Walker received 1,947 votes, and Bill Smith received 1,252 votes. Their names will appear on the 2009 Boulder City General Election ballot. Of these two candidates, the one receiving the highest number of votes in the General Election will be elected as a City Council member.
