

NOTICE INVITING BIDS

RECEIPT OF PROPOSALS: Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the Director of Community Development, City of Boulder City, Nevada, Owner of the work located at City Hall, 401 California Avenue, Boulder City, Nevada 89005, until 1:00 PM, Tuesday, March 9, 2010, for the project Runway 15-33 Safety Enhancements, AIP 3-32-0003-17.

SITE OF WORK: The site of the work is located within the City limits of Boulder City, Nevada.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: This work shall include furnishing all labor, material and equipment to Rehabilitate Runway 15-33 pavements and safety areas at the Boulder City Municipal Airport. Project will include, but not be limited to, site work, grading, paving and electrical.

COMPLETION OF WORK: All work must be completed within one-hundred six (106) calendar days after date of Notice to Proceed by the Owner.

OPENING OF PROPOSALS: The proposals will be publicly opened and read at 1:00 P.M. Tuesday, March 9, 2010 in City Hall.

PRE-BID CONFERENCE: A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at the Boulder City Municipal Airport on Tuesday, March 2, 2010 at 1:00 P.M.

PREVAILING WAGE RATES: Wage rates on the project shall meet current Davis-Bacon Wage Rates.

DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE): There is no DBE project goal established for this project. At this time, the City of Boulder City will meet the DBE goal on federally assisted projects through race neutral measures. Boulder City supports the use of race neutral measures to facilitate participation by DBEs and other small businesses, and encourages prime contractors to subcontract portions of their work that they might otherwise perform with their own forces.

OWNER'S RIGHTS RESERVED: The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality in a bid, and to make awards in the interest of the Owner.

QUALIFICATION OF BIDDER: At the time of bidding, a bidder must hold a valid license of a class corresponding to the work to be performed, in accordance with the provisions of the Nevada State Contractor's License Law.

PROPOSAL GUARANTEE: Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond in an amount not less than 10 percent of the total bid price, payable to the City of Boulder City as a guarantee that the bidder, if his proposal is accepted, will promptly execute the contract. Workman's compensation insurance, faithful performance bond in the amount of 100 percent of the total bid price, a labor and material bond in the amount of 100 percent of the total bid price, and a guarantee bond will be executed as part of the contract agreement.

REQUIREMENTS: The City anticipates that Project will be funded through a combination of Federal and local funds. The project, is therefore, subject all applicable City, County, State and Federal requirements, including, but not limited to the following:

- Buy American Preferences (*Title 49 United States Code, CHAPTER 501*)
- Foreign Trade Restriction: Denial of Public Works Contracts to Suppliers of Goods and Services of Countries that Deny Contracts to Suppliers of Goods and Services of Countries that Deny Procurement Market Access to U.S. Contractors (*DOT Regulation 49 CFR PART 30*)
- Davis Bacon Act (DOL Regulation 29 CFR Part 5)
- State of Nevada Prevailing Wages, NRS Chapter 338
- State of Nevada Contractor Licensing, NRS, Chapter 624
- Affirmative Action to Ensure Equal Employment Opportunity (Executive Order 11246 and DOL Regulation 41 CFR PART 60)
- Governmentwide Debarment and Suspension and Governmentwide Requirements for Drug-free Workplace (DOT Regulation 49 CFR PART 29)
- A contractor having 50 or more employees and his subcontractors having 50 or more employees and who may be awarded a contract of \$50,000 or more will be required to maintain an affirmative action program, the standards for which are contained in the specifications.
- The City of Boulder City does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, or sex in the award and performance of any DOT assisted contract or in the administration of its DBE Program or the requirements of 49 CFR Part 26. The City of Boulder City shall take all necessary and reasonable steps under 49 CFR Part 26 to ensure non-discrimination in the award and administration of DOT assisted contracts. The City of Boulder City's DBE Program, as required by 49 CFR Part 26 and as approved by DOT, is incorporated by reference in this agreement.
- The contractor shall require all subcontractors on any first tier subcontracts in excess of \$50,000 and who employ 50 or more employees to file a compliance report (SF 100) prior to award of the subcontract.
- All prospective bidders must furnish financial responsibility and pre-qualification information or evidence that they are qualified to do this work.
