

RESOLUTION NO. 5025

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BOULDER CITY,
NEVADA, REPEALING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION NO.
3090, AMENDING THE BUSINESS LICENSE FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, Section 4-1-22 of the Boulder City Code provides for the licensing of businesses, trades, professions, and callings within the city limits of the City of Boulder City, Nevada and required the City Council to set the stipulated fees and penalties by resolution; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 3090, effective February 1, 1998, had previously been adopted to set the stipulated fees and penalties: and

WHEREAS, City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1508 at its June 26, 2007, regular meeting, which amends the City Code Title 4, Chapter 1, Section 22, License Classification and Fees; and

WHEREAS, As part of Ordinance No. 1508, additional terminology had been included relating to non-profit organizations and special events fees; and

WHEREAS, It is desirable to update the business license fee schedule to include the new fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 3090 be repealed in its entirety; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following schedule of fees is hereby fixed for the licenses, permits, and penalties stipulated in Section 4-1-22 of the Boulder City Code:

1. RESIDENT. The point value for a Resident business License is hereby fixed at ONE AND ONE-HALF CENTS (1.5¢), which multiplied by the total number of points applied, will give the semiannual license rate.
 - A. The minimum semiannual license fee shall be FORTY DOLLARS (\$40.00), unless otherwise provided in this Resolution
2. RESIDENT CONTRACTOR. ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) shall be charged for an annual resident Contractor's License or SIXTY-FIVE, dollars (\$65.00) for a semiannual resident Contractor's License, which fee shall be in addition to any other business license fee.
3. RESIDENT TRADESMAN. ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) shall be charged for an annual Resident Tradesman's License or SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$65.00) for a semiannual resident Tradesman's License.

4. HOME OCCUPATION BUSINESS. The permit fee for a Home Occupation Business is hereby fixed at ONE AND ONE-HALF CENTS (1.5¢), which multiplied by the total number of points applied, will give the semiannual license fee
 - A. The minimum semiannual permit fee, regardless of the computation as herein stipulated, shall be FORTY DOLLARS (\$40.00).
5. RESIDENTIAL RENTAL UNITS. The license fee for Resident Rental Units will be computed under the same point system and unit of point value as stipulated above for a Resident license
 - A. The minimum semiannual license fee shall be FORTY DOLLARS (\$40.00), which shall be in addition to any other business license fee.
6. NON-PROFIT PERMITS. The fee for a Non-Profit permit shall be TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) per year.
 - A. If the proposed business or service, with the exception of churches, will be a full-time business, the fees for the Non-profit Permit shall be computed on the basis of the point system provided in Section 4-1-22 of the Business License Code.
7. NON-RESIDENT. A non-resident business shall pay a fee on the following basis:
 - A. Business of retail nature, excluding vendors of coin-operated machines – ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$175.00) annual fee or ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) semiannual fee.
 - B. Business of a service nature –ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) annual fee or SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$65.00) semiannual fee.
 - C. Business of a wholesale nature – ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) annual fee or SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$65.00) semiannual fee.
 - D. One-time Permit. The fees for a special One-time Permit shall be as follows:
 - (1) TWENTY DOLLARS (\$20.00) – providing the value of such goods or services does not exceed \$500.00.
