## RESULTS OF CANVASS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION IN THE CITY OF BOULDER CITY JUNE 14, 2022

The results of the June 14, 2022 Primary Election were canvassed comparing the computer printout of ballots counted and the results thereof with the official ballot statements for the 6 precincts used in the election.

There was 1 discrepancy in the 5,159 ballots cast in the 6 precincts, however, there were no tabulation errors in the 6 precincts, and the foregoing discrepancy would not alter the outcome of any race in this Primary Election.

Nineteen provisional ballots were cast during the election, 17 were verified and counted, and 2 were rejected because the voters were not registered to vote.

Audits were performed according to 293B on the hash code of our ICX voting machines and the VVPAT rolls for 2% of all machines used in the election. No discrepancies were identified. The accuracy certification board also certified the functionality of our tabulation system, to include our mail readers, ICX voting machines, Agilis mail ballot processing machine, and tabulation system. All systems were found to be 100% accurate in the tabulation of votes and processing of mail ballots. The tests were performed before the start of early voting, the day before Election Day, and a post-election test the day after the election.

Therefore, as the duly appointed Registrar of Voters of Clark County, Nevada, I do hereby approve the canvassed results of the Primary Election for certification.




We, the undersigned members of the Accuracy Certification Board for the June 14, 2022 Primary Election, do hereby certify that the automatic tabulating equipment and programs for said election were tested for the following conditions and correctly counted the votes cast for all candidates in all offices and precincts.

1. In accordance with NRS 293B.155 (1), a pre audited group of logic and accuracy test ballots was so marked as to record a predetermined number of valid votes for each candidate and included for the office one or more ballots which have votes in excess of the number allowed by law in order to test the ability of the automatic tabulating equipment and programs to reject those votes; additionally, in accordance with Nevada Election Regulation 293B.080 for the type of ballot used in the county, the test deck contained not less than the same number of ballots as there are valid voting positions for an office; and allowed for the testing of each precinct, including the preparation of a cumulative report of the total votes cast for each voting position and a total count of the number of precincts.

  - (a) Any invalid voting of a ballot will cause it to be rejected;
  - (b) Votes can be counted for each candidate and proposition;
  - (c) Any overvote for an office or proposition will cause a rejection of the vote for that office or proposition.
  - (d) When multiple votes may be cast, the maximum number of votes permitted a voter cannot be exceeded without rejecting the vote for that selection, but any undervote will be counted;
  - (e) Neither a voter's omission to vote nor his irregular vote on any particular office or proposition on the ballot will prevent the counting of his vote as to any other office or proposition on the ballot.


3. The Board has verified that the computer or counting device was tested to determine how the system responds to:

We, the undersigned members of the Accuracy Certification Board for the June 14, 2022 Primary Election, do hereby certify that the automatic tabulating equipment and programs for said election were tested for the following conditions and correctly counted the votes cast for all candidates in all offices and precincts.

1. In accordance with NRS 293B.155 (1), a pre audited group of logic and accuracy test ballots was so marked as to record a predetermined number of valid votes for each candidate and included for the office one or more ballots which have votes in excess of the number allowed by law in order to test the ability of the automatic tabulating equipment and programs to reject those votes; additionally, in accordance with Nevada Election Regulation 293B.080 for the type of ballot used in the county, the test deck contained not less than the same number of ballots as there are valid voting positions for an office; and allowed for the testing of each precinct, including the preparation of a cumulative report of the total votes cast for each voting position and a total count of the number of precincts.

## Post-Election Certification 2022 Primary Election Audit of Voting Machine Firmware and Operating Systems

In accordance with Chapter 293B of the Nevada Administrative Code, an audit was conducted of 36 (2% of 1,795) machines used in the election. The sample of 36 ICX machines was randomly selected from the group of machines used during the early voting period and on Election Day. The audit was conducted as follows:

- a. For each machine selected, the digital signature of the ICX firmware was verified against the hash code values published by the National Institute of Science and Technology (NIST) on the National Software Reference Library (NSRL).
- b. The results were compared.

The results of the audit showed that 100% of the time, the voting machine firmware hash code values matched the hash code values registered on the National Software Reference Library.

## Post-Election Certification 2022 Primary Election

### Audit of Voter Verifiable Paper Trail Printers

In accordance with Chapter 293B of the Nevada Administrative Code, an audit was conducted of 36 (2% of 1,795) machines used in the election. The randomly selected ICX touchscreen voting machines, and the voter verifiable paper trail printer that was used with each machine, were used in this audit. The audit was conducted as follows:

- a. For each machine selected, the printed record produced by the machine during voting was manually tabulated by a panel of Clark County Election Department staff members.
- b. The electronically recorded results for each machine were independently tabulated using the election tabulation software.
- c. The results were compared.

The results of the audit showed that 100% of the time, the electronically recorded results exactly matched the selections printed on the paper tape.
