



Available Volunteer Opportunities:

Transportation Volunteer

Lend A Hand of Boulder City volunteers transport senior and/or disabled Boulder City residents. Mileage is reimbursed monthly at .52 cents per mile.

- Transport individual clients to medical appointments outside of Boulder City (LV, NLV, Henderson, etc.)
- Transport individual clients to medical appointments or local errands within Boulder City.

In-Home Volunteer

Lend A Hand of Boulder City volunteers assist clients with in home tasks so that they can remain independent in their own home.

- Light housekeeping (dust, vacuum, etc. NO bathrooms)
- Laundry
- Change bed linens, make bed
- Companionship
- Respite for caregivers
- Reassurance calls
- Light meal prep
- Minor home upkeep (change light bulbs/AC filter)
- Pet walking
- Trash/Recycles
- Mail

Potential volunteers will be required to fill out a volunteer application, provide two references, complete finger printing and a background check (at our cost), and attend a volunteer class at the Lend A Hand office.

Volunteer schedules are extremely flexible. Assignments are available 7 days a week and coordinators will work with the volunteer's availability. Even once a week could be a tremendous help to keep our no cost services available to Boulder City residents.
