The Boulder City Historic Preservation Commission has determined the Boulder City Historic Preservation Award for 2023 is hereby granted to:


### **The Wengert-Rackey House at 524 Birch Street**


Located within the Boulder City Historic District as listed in the National Register of Historic Places, the 524 Birch Street house was selected for this award because:

- The Spanish Ranch-style home, built in 1937 for Los Angeles Bureau of Power and Light (LABPL) employees, continues to retain its original features including red clay barrel-tile roof, stucco walls, wood double-hung windows, and landscaping.
- This and twenty-one other LABPL houses located on Birch Street have been so well preserved that since 1982, they have maintained their eligibility for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.
- Thanks to previous and ongoing preservation efforts and minimal alterations, the home is an important property that helps retain the historic integrity and character of the Birch Street neighborhood and the Historic District.




