



What's Happening around the City of Boulder City

Happy Public Power Week!



Boulder City's Utilities Department provides power to more than 8,000 residential and business customers. We are one of 2,000 public power utilities that provide electricity to 49 million people across the country. We recognize Public Power Week, which runs Sunday, October 1 through Saturday, October 7. Boulder City is still one of the lowest-cost providers in the country.

Boulder City receives more than half of its power from renewable hydroelectric sources (forty percent is generated by the engineering wonder that built our community - Hoover Dam; Glen Canyon Dam on Lake Powell provides 12-percent). About a quarter of our power comes from solar energy from Townsite Solar, the other quarter from natural gas. This year, the Electric Division is working to educate a future generation of potential public power employees: Wednesday, October 4, from 1:30 until 3:00, students at Martha P. King Elementary School will learn about their work and some will go up in a bucket truck to see from the vantage point of our employees!

SNWA Receives Federal Funding for BC Wastewater



Last week, Senator Catherine Cortez Masto announced \$1 million in federal funding for the Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA) to design a wastewater recycling system for Boulder City in an effort to address the drought impacting Lake Mead. "With the ongoing drought, we need to continue to do everything we can to maximize our water resources, and that's why I've worked so hard to expand our water recycling programs in Nevada and throughout the West," said Senator Cortez Masto. Masto has been a leader in the Senate working to support conservation efforts and combat drought. In addition to a large-scale water recycling program included in the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, she also sought \$4 billion to combat drought in the states bordering the Colorado River in the Inflation Reduction Act.
