The Boulder City Historic Preservation Commission and City Council award (a plaque and certificate) recognizes the hard work of our local citizens in their efforts to maintain and enhance the architectural, historical, and cultural heritage of Boulder City. The Commission will select an awardee in April. The award recipient will be recognized by City Council via individual video to be posted online to the City's webpage and social media accounts during Historic Preservation Month, May 2024. Nominations are open now through Sunday, March 10, 2024. Projects must be located within the Boulder City Historic District (see map), and only exterior views of the property (readily visible from the street) will be considered.
