## City Launches Webpage regarding Pool Funding



The current Boulder City pool is forty-four years old and has reached a critical point of disrepair. Replacing it will allow the continuation of programs that the community has come to appreciate, provide compliance with current health codes, and meet the accessibility requirements for Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Boulder City created a web page to keep residents informed and educated regarding plans to replace it. Due to rising inflation increasing the cost of materials

and labor, construction is now estimated at \$36 million (up from \$27 million in 2023). In November, City staff will ask voter approval to use up to \$9 million from the CIP fund, in addition to the \$7 million previously approved by voters. Ballot language, funding source information and SCA plan designs are posted at [www.bcnv.org/newpool](http://www.bcnv.org/newpool). “Staff and Council have worked to create a funding plan that does not propose to add to, change or repeal existing law, and will not increase taxes or fees,” said City Manager Taylour Tedder. “The City needs to replace the facility before repairs are no longer fiscally sound.” Money in the Capital Improvement Fund that is not spent as approved by the voters may not be spent on any other project without voter approval.
