Save the Date - Historic Preservation Day is Approaching!



Mark your calendars for Historic Preservation Day on May 11, 2024! This year's theme is **Trains, Planes and Automobiles**. Events for parents and kids are scheduled to start at 8:00 a.m. at the Nevada State Railroad Museum, 600 Yucca Street. Pick up an event schedule and map, get some refreshments, and view original railroad equipment that helped build Hoover Dam! Train rides are available at 10:00 a.m., noon, 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. (cost is \$10 for adults, \$5 for children).

From 10:00 a.m. until 11:30 a.m., visit the old Bullock/Boulder City Airport! Known as the "biggest airport in the West" when it was built in 1933, it was a hub for tourists visiting Las Vegas, Lake Mead, and the Grand Canyon. (Parking available near 1401 Boulder City Parkway.) From noon-1:00 p.m., check out the Boulder City Company Store, 525 Avenue B. Store owner Tara Leon-Bertoli will share the story behind her dad's 1928 DeSoto Six edition, which has 100% of the original components.
