## Vehicle Pursuit Investigation

**Boulder City, NV** [June 19, 2024]— On the evening of June 18, 2024 around 7:00 PM, the Boulder City Police Department received a request to assist the Arizona Department of Public Safety Highway Patrol (AZDPS) as they were attempting to stop a reported stolen Motorhome. BCPD continually received updates from the National Park Service (NPS) and the AZDPS about the location of the vehicle, and AZDPS/NPS attempts to stop it. National Park Service Law Enforcement Rangers unsuccessfully attempted to deploy spike strips to stop the motorhome on several occasions, and the vehicle continued to flee into Boulder City.

BCPD officers assisted NPS and AZ DPS as their pursuit continued into Boulder City. During the pursuit, a female suspect jumped from the motorhome while it was in motion and was taken into custody. During the pursuit, the motorhome fled through city streets, and into the Bootleg Canyon trail head. The driver abandoned the motorhome near US93 (truck route) and Canyon Road on a bicycle he had inside the motorhome. An Arizona DPS helicopter assisted in tracking the suspect, later identified as Joshua BAILEY as he fled on the bicycle further into residential neighborhoods.

With the assistance of the AZDPS airship, BCPD officers were able to locate the BAILEY on Shirley Lane. BAILEY was apprehended by BCPD officers in the 800 block of Shirley Lane. BAILEY and a BCPD Officer were transported to the Boulder City Hospital for treatment of minor injuries. Our Officer was treated and released and is at home recovering from his injuries.

After being released from the hospital several hours later, BAILEY was transported to the Clark County Detention Center and booked on the charges of possession of stolen vehicle, conspiracy to elude evade a peace officer, reckless driving x2, driving with a suspended license, and failure to stop and give information at the scene of a crash. Additionally, he was booked on numerous felony charges by the Henderson Police Department for crimes he had previously committed in the City of Henderson; as well as a warrant of arrest from the City of Henderson, and he will await further charges from the Arizona Department of Public Safety for the crimes he is suspected of committing in Arizona.

The female passenger was transported to and booked at the Henderson Detention Center for an outstanding felony warrant from Henderson Police Department.
