Longtime BC Employee Promoted to Public Works Director

BOULDER CITY – After nearly three decades of working his way up the ranks here in Boulder City, Gary Poindexter was announced as the new Public Works Director. Poindexter brings twenty-seven years of experience of working in the City’s Public Works Department. He studied at College of Southern Nevada, University of Nevada Las Vegas and University of Phoenix, and holds a Bachelor’s Degree in Business with a focus on public sector.

He is a Boulder City High School graduate, having moved here as a young child in the late 1970’s. His career with the City of Boulder City started as a temporary Street Maintenance Worker in 1996, and promoted to full-time Water and Wastewater Maintenance Worker in 1997.

Poindexter has a unique view of each role in Public Works. “This journey, from the ground up, culminated in my appointment as Public Works Superintendent in 2010 which turned into Public Works & Utilities Superintendent in 2011 until 2018, when the departments were separated again,” Gary said. “I appreciate this opportunity and am eager to bring my diverse skill set, expertise, and drive to the executive team.”

Poindexter holds a number of Public Works related certifications and training in electric, water, wastewater, streets and landscaping. These qualifications, his project management and asset management experience, ability to work with external vendors, and his dedication to training his staff made him the top choice of City Manager Taylour Tedder, who announced the decision today.

“The search brought us many wonderful candidates, but Gary’s experience, skills and personality make him a great fit for this role,” said Taylour Tedder, City Manager for Boulder City.* “There are many functions our Public Works leadership and staff are responsible to tackle, including working closely with the Finance and Utilities Departments. I believe Gary has proven his strengths and abilities over the years.”

Poindexter has two children: Sabrina, 20 and Tyler, 17. He and his fiancé Katy live in Boulder City with Tyler, Katy’s son Trenton, 15, and their two dogs, Thor and Hunter. He replaces Jamie Curreri, who held the role since September 2022 and left the position last week for the private sector.
