Possess a valid Nevada Driver's License & maintain a satisfactory driving record.

Have no felony convictions.

Have no misdemeanor convictions within two years of filing application. Possess competent written/verbal English skills.

Successfully complete the required background investigation requirements.

Be available on weekdays, approximately 10 hours a month.
