

Boulder City Historic Preservation Award for 2024

The Boulder City Historic Preservation Commission has determined the Boulder City Historic Preservation Award for 2024 is hereby granted to:


Los Angeles Department of Water & Power Lodge

Located within the Boulder City Historic District as listed in the National Register of Historic Places, the Lodge at 1400 Lodge Road was selected for this award because:

- Built in 1931, the Six Companies Executive Lodge was originally built to house the directors of Six Companies, Inc. a joint venture of construction companies that was formed to build the Hoover Dam.
- Six Companies Architect George DeColmesnil sited the ten-room, six-bedroom Spanish Revival Style Lodge with commanding views of Boulder City and Lake Mead.
- The Lodge continues to retain its historic integrity for listing in the National Register of Historic Places due to ongoing care and preservation by the Los Angeles Department of Power and Water.
