

# Boulder City Historic Preservation Award for 2025

The Boulder City Historic Preservation Commission has determined the Boulder City Historic Preservation Award for 2025 is hereby granted to:

## **St. Christopher's Episcopal Church**

Located within the Boulder City Historic District as listed in the National Register of Historic Places,


St. Christopher's Episcopal Church at 812 Arizona Street was selected for this award because:

- Built in 1932, the St. Christopher's Episcopal Church was one of the first churches established in Boulder City, playing a significant role in fostering early community cohesion.
- Designed by architects H.C. Nordstrom and P.A. Warner, it is the only recorded example of a New Traditional: Tudor Folk Style structure in the Historic District, characterized by a rectangular steeple tower, gabled transept, faux half-timbering, tall narrow windows, and a rounded-arch entrance accessed by a long series of steps.
- The building continues to retain its historic integrity for listing in the National Register of Historic Places due to continued care and preservation efforts by the church.
