




World's Largest Swimming Lesson Returns June 26



Boulder City's Parks and Recreation Department is thrilled to once again take part in the World's Largest Swimming Lesson next week. Lessons will be offered at an estimated 600 locations in more than 20 countries on that day. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, more children ages 1-4 die from drowning than any other cause of death. Drowning is the second leading cause of accidental death for children ages 5-14. Research shows that formal swimming lessons can reduce the risk of drowning by 88% among children ages 1-4. In addition to this annual event, our Parks and Recreation Department recently received a \$2500 grant from the Southern Nevada Chapter of the International Code Council to provide free swim lessons for toddlers 0-4

years of age. Pre-registration begins an hour before the lesson starts: 11:00 a.m. on June 26. There is no charge to participate. Learn more about the event by visiting www.wsl.org.
