



Bike Safety Ordinance Starts Thursday

This summer, City Council approved an ordinance to establish strong, comprehensive regulations for the operation of bicycles, electric bicycles, electric scooters, skates, toy vehicles, scooters and skateboards. Effective on September 18, 2025, this code covers circumstances that are not addressed in state law. Boulder City's ordinance will be the strongest in Clark County, as it makes helmets mandatory for all minors on regular bicycles, in addition to e-bikes and e-scooters. The ordinance adds definitions for bicycles, electric bicycles, electric scooters, roller skates, scooters and skateboards; establishes a speed limit of 15 miles per hour for all devices operating on the sidewalk or multi-use path (with the exception of the River Mountains Loop Trail); prohibits all motorized forms of transportation,

including electric bicycles and scooters from being ridden upon recreational facilities in City parks such as grass, fields, playgrounds, or courts, and more. "The new requirements are intended to help parents keep their children safe," said City Manager Ned Thomas. "We are grateful for grants that have made it possible for Boulder City Fire Department to provide free helmets to 150 kids so far this year."
