




What's Happening around the City of Boulder City

CCSD, BC Team Up to Keep Kids Safe



Sunday, a tragic accident happened in Las Vegas: a 12-year-old boy was killed in an e-scooter accident; he was not wearing a helmet. Emergency personnel in Clark County estimate they are responding to four accidents a day involving bikes, e-bikes and e-scooters. It's a grim reminder of the dangers of these devices. Boulder City's new ordinance on bikes, e-bikes and e-scooters went into effect last week. Our ordinance is the strongest in Clark County, as it makes helmets mandatory for all minors on bikes, e-bikes and e-scooters. On Thursday, when the ordinance went into effect, the Clark County School District "Safe Routes to School" program teamed up with BC Fire and Police Departments and the City Manager's Office to distribute more than 130 free helmets. (That's in addition to 150 given away this summer by BCFD.) Media Coordinator Carly Poindexter (with the help of her children Violet and Geddy) put together a great video to learn about the ordinance at www.bcnv.org/bikesafety. Boulder City Police and Fire Departments will be providing more free helmets (for residents only) during the Bike Rodeo at National Night Out on Tuesday, October 7, 2025 at Veterans Memorial Park from 5 p.m.-8 p.m. or while supplies last.
