

ORDINANCE NO. 1871

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BOULDER CITY, NEVADA TO AMEND TITLE 2 OF THE CITY CODE, DEPARTMENTS, CHAPTER 5 POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO MODIFY THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT INCLUDING THE REQUIREMENT TO ESTABLISH A VOLUNTARY MOUNTED POLICE UNIT

The City Council of Boulder City do ordain:


Section 1. Boulder City, Nevada, does by this Ordinance hereby amend Boulder City Municipal Code, Title 2, Chapter 5 (Police Department) as provided for in **Exhibit A**.

Section 2. VALIDITY. Each section and each provision or requirement of any section of this ordinance shall be considered separable and the invalidity of any portion shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other portion.


Section 3. PUBLICATION. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published in summary on November 14, 2025, in the *Las Vegas Review-Journal*, a daily newspaper, published in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Section 4 EFFECTIVE. This Ordinance shall become effective, after its approval and publication, on the 4th day of December 2025.



## ***Chapter 5 POLICE DEPARTMENT***

### **2-5-1. DEPARTMENT CREATED.**

There is hereby created the Police Department of the City.

### **2-5-2. DIRECTOR.**

- A. *Appointment.* The department head of the Police Department shall bear the title of Director of the Police Department and Chief of Police. He/she shall be appointed by the City Manager.
- B. *Compensation.* The salary of the Director of the Police Department shall be as set from time to time by the City Council.

### **2-5-3. DUTIES OF DEPARTMENT.**

The Police Department shall be generally responsible for the following duties:

- A. *Protection Of Life and Property.* The protection of life and property for those living, working and or visiting the City
- B. *Enforcement Of Laws.* The enforcement of the Constitution of the United States, the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, the City Charter and the ordinances adopted by the City Council.
- C. *Crime Prevention Program.* The adoption of programs and policies for crime awareness and prevention and reduction of traffic collisions and violations..
- D. *Other Duties:* And all other duties properly pertaining to the above. (Ord. 16, 12-28-1959, eff. 1-4-1960)
