### **Police Investigate Shooting, Vandalism of Vehicle**

**BOULDER CITY , NV** – Boulder City Police received numerous complaints of vandalism and gunfire from Friday night and Saturday morning (January 9 and 10, 2026). The calls came from the 700 block of Christina and 700 block of Capri. Officers believe the calls are connected.

The initial call of shots fired came to 911 dispatch on Friday, January 9 at 10:11 p.m. Boulder City Police immediately responded in the 700 block of Christina Drive but did not find any evidence of a shooting.

An hour later, about 1/10<sup>th</sup> of a mile east of the first 911 call, a woman in the 700 block of Capri called 911 and said her boyfriend vandalized her truck. She suspected he was intoxicated. Police went to her home, but no one answered the door.

Thirty minutes later - just before midnight - the caller on Capri again called 911 and said her car alarm was going off and her boyfriend was “smashing” her truck. She said she wanted to speak with officers.

Officers arrived at the caller’s residence on Capri, where they spoke with both the caller and her boyfriend. The caller told police she did not want to press charges.

The next morning, another resident called 911 and said he found what he believed to be a bullet hole in his car in the 700 of Capri Drive in Boulder City. Dayshift officers found a hole in the car and found a bullet, likely from a 9mm. Officers saw the boyfriend, who was walking around the scene and removing evidence. He was arrested and is awaiting arraignment. “We are fortunate that nobody was hurt in this incident,” Chief Shea said. “If any residents in the area have video connected to the shooting, please let us know.”
