You can always mail your payment to 401, California Ave, 89005, but if you want to save the stamp, you can place your payment in the convenient drop box located at the north end of the City Hall parking lot. You don't even have to leave the comfort of your car!

Don't have exact change? You don't need to navigate all the stairs in City Hall to make your payment in person. We have a convenient customer service window located in the back of the building between City Hall and the Parks and Recreation Center. 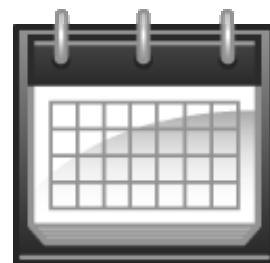

January 24, 2017	Candidate filing begins

February 15, 2017	Financial Disclosure form must be filed
March 4, 2017	Last day to register to vote for the Primary Election, without appearing in person at the Boulder City City Clerk's Office
March 5 – March 14, 2017	Close of Registration for the Primary Election
March 14, 2017	Contribution & Expense Report No. 1 must be filed
March 14, 2017	Last day for City Clerk to receive requests for absentee Ballots for the Primary Election
March 22, 2017	Early voting for the Primary Election begins
March 31, 2017	Contribution & Expense Report No. 2 must be filed
April 4, 2017	<b>PRIMARY ELECTION DAY</b>
April 11, 2017	City Council meeting to canvass returns and declare results
April 17, 2017	Last day to request recount for Primary Election
May 13, 2017	Last day to register to vote for the General Election, without appearing in person at the Boulder City City Clerk's office
May 14 – May 23, 2017	Close of Registration for the General Election
May 23, 2017	Contribution & Expense Report No. 3 must be electronically filed
May 31, 2017	Early voting for the General Election begins
June 3, 2017	Early voting for the General Election ends
June 6, 2017	Last day for City Clerk to receive requests for absentee Ballots for the Primary Election
June 9, 2017	Contribution & Expense Report No. 4 must be electronically filed
June 13, 2017	<b>GENERAL ELECTION DAY</b>
June 20, 2017	Special City Council meeting to canvass returns and declare results
June 26, 2017	Last day to request recount
June 27, 2017	First meeting for new Council members
August 15, 2017	Last day to dispose of unspent contributions for candidates elected or defeated in the General Election
