## Congratulations to Nevada's Judge of the Year!



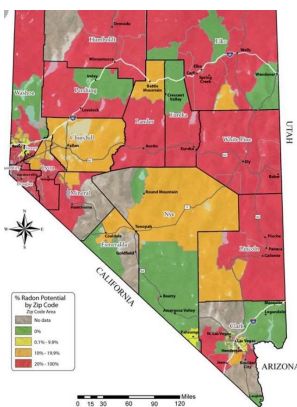

January is National Radon Action Month. Radon is an odorless, colorless, radioactive gas that can cause lung cancer. In Boulder City, test results show that 18% of homes tested had elevated radon concentrations. Mayor Rod Woodbury has signed a proclamation to bring awareness to this issue. We hope this proclamation will help inspire more testing in Boulder City, as winter is the best time to test for radon.
