Grant to Help Boulder City's Homeless Pets

BOULDER CITY – Boulder City Animal Control will receive a \$25,000 grant from Maddie's® Pet Project in Nevada, made possible by the generosity of Dave & Cheryl Duffield Foundation, #ThanksToMaddie. Shelter Supervisor Ann Inabnitt and Police Chief Tim Shea will receive the grant at the February 12, 2019 City Council meeting at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall.

The award funds the following:

\$12,000 - Spay/neuter/vaccines and other vet care through Heaven Can Wait

\$10,000 – Advertising of pets seeking loving new homes

\$3,000 – Cat Colony Room (cat condos/cat trees for more natural habitat)

"This award will help us take better control of our pet population through spay/neutering, vaccination and vet care for our stray and unwanted pets," said Inabnitt. "Boulder City Animal Control is deeply grateful to Dave & Cheryl Duffield Foundation for its generous support of our organization and commitment to improving the lives of dogs and cats throughout Nevada. We also thank the Boulder City community members who have been incredibly supportive of our mission here."

"Ann's leadership is incredible. The shelter now qualifies as a no kill shelter, with about 96-percent of the animals taken in being adopted or placed in foster homes," said Chief Tim Shea. "She's even earned a scholarship to the Humane Society of the United States conference in New Orleans in April through a grant made possible by Maddie's® Pet Project in Nevada. She truly provides a voice for our homeless pets."
