**Boulder City Staff Receives Award for
Excellence in Financial Reporting**

BOULDER CITY – The Finance Department and the City of Boulder City received a top honor from a well-regarded national financial organization. The Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA) awarded Boulder City the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting for its 2018 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR).

This is the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting, and its attainment represents a significant accomplishment by a government and its management. “The Finance Department’s incredible team effort in putting together our Comprehensive Annual Fund Report demonstrates our dedication to fiscal responsibility and transparency,” said Diane Pelletier, Finance Director for Boulder City. “I’m proud of the hard work and dedication this team has shown to the community.”

The CAFR is judged by an impartial panel to meet the high standards of the program. Principles include a spirit of full disclosure, clearly communicating the community’s financial story and encouraging residents to read the CAFR. “We have a team of professionals who go above and beyond for the residents of Boulder City,” said Mayor Rod Woodbury. “We are fortunate to have the incredible staff here making sure information is shared in a complete and accurate fashion.”
