The water main near your property will be turned off for improvements to the water system in your neighborhood. During this time, you will be unable to use water for any purpose.

How to Prepare for a Water Service Shutdown:

You may wish to store tap water in your refrigerator or drink bottled water. You may need to turn off any equipment that uses water such as evaporative coolers and notify your fire sprinkler system monitoring company.

What to Expect Following a Water Service Shutdown:

When there is a water shutdown, the sediment that naturally occurs in the water piping system is disturbed. This disturbance can cause the water from the faucets and toilets to appear rust colored. You will notice this discoloration when the water service resumes. There may also be air in the line in which water spurts from faucets or is cloudy. Once the service returns, running the cold water for a few minutes from your bathtub faucet will clear the water of rust discoloration. Opening the highest faucet in the building should force out trapped air.
