Boulder City Police Reminds Drivers to Watch their Speed

BOULDER CITY – Don't let your Independence Day plans fizzle out because of a speeding ticket – or worse yet, an accident. Through Sunday, July 12, 2020, the Boulder City Police Department will be on the lookout for speeding drivers on the roads. Officers are once again **"Joining Forces"** with our regional partners to make sure drivers are being safe and keeping the speedometer within the posted speed limit.

The Boulder City Police Department, along with other agencies throughout the Valley, will be conducting extra patrols during this period. Drivers are urged to slow down and drive with caution so they can arrive alive. Citations for speeding can cost \$200 or more and impact your insurance premiums.

"People take for granted the impact even the slightest mistake can create when speeding," said Boulder City Police Chief Tim Shea. "Just a slight error or misjudgment can send a car careening off-road or into another vehicle. Our officers have pulled over drivers on I-11 driving more than 100 miles per hour, which could have deadly outcomes."
