Thursday, they received their Boulder City Firefighter badge and are officially Firefighter Reserves. "We are hoping to grow the program to around 25-30 reserve firefighters over the next 18-24 months. We hope to grow the program's diversity at the same time so that it better reflect the community we serve."
