The Boulder City Historic Preservation Committee has determined that the Boulder City Historic Preservation Award for 2020 is hereby granted to:

The Brimhall House at 1342 Denver Street

Located within the Boulder City Historic District as listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the Brimhall residence was selected for this award because:


- Great care was taken to renovate one of the first permanent residences built in 1931 by the Bureau of Reclamation.
- The multi-year renovation helped maintain the historic character of the Denver Street neighborhood.
- The homeowners preserved important character defining features such as the Spanish Colonial Revival Style windows, front entry, and roof.
- The outdoor dining area added to the rear of the home blends well with the original dwelling.


