



## City Hall Closes to Public Starting Wednesday



Mayor Kiernan McManus, City Council, the Acting City Manager and staff are working to protect you and our community during the recent surge in COVID-19 cases. The announcement of a Statewide Pause by Governor Steve Sisolak City led leaders to examine current operations, and how we can slow the spread of the virus. Starting Wednesday, December 2, 2020, City offices will close to the public, in a similar manner as in March 2020.

- City Council, Committee and Commission meetings will be live streamed only (residents still have opportunities to provide input via email, online form or call-in; see [www.bcnv.org/Council](http://www.bcnv.org/Council) for details)
- The public will still be able to use windows to conduct business and submit payments, permits, etc.
- Residents can drop items off at the front door security desk of City Hall
- All indoor Parks and Recreation activities will be cancelled with the following exceptions:
  - ◇ Tiny Tots
  - ◇ Safekey
  - ◇ Fitness Center
  - ◇ Swimming Pool – pool only
- If classes can be held outdoors (i.e. dog obedience) then the class can continue, but only outside. For Parks and Recreation activities that are allowed, participants and observers must follow State directives regarding occupancy and wear a mask.
