



What's Happening around the City of Boulder City

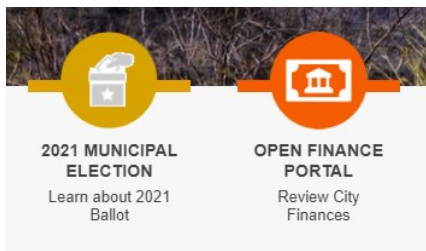
Welcome to Kristol Bias, City Manager's Office!
